- 4) What role does trust play in the marriage depicted? How does it evolve over time?
- 5) How does motherhood shape Annabelle's sense of self? Does it strengthen or complicate her decisions?
- 6) What would you do in Annabelle's place if your instincts told you something was wrong but no one believed you?
- 7) What does the novel say about believing women? Especially when their fears or doubts aren't taken seriously?
- 8) How do the dreams in the novel blur the line between reality and fear? Did any particular dream or vision linger with you?
- 9) How does Annabelle navigate the tension between being a mother and pursuing her own ambitions?
- 10) How does the novel portray the way women are judged for their choices, whether they focus on family, work or both?
- 11) How does the novel reflect the pressures teenagers face online in curating their image and self-worth?
- 12) What role do parents or guardians play in helping teens navigate the digital world? Are they equipped to understand this?
